Aviation Quilt Block Contest

✦ 2010 Entry Form ✦

Aviation quilt blocks of not more than 12" x 12" will be considered in the 2010 contest.

Quilt block designs may include vintage or contemporary aircraft or be representations of propeller designs. As many aviation quilt blocks as possible will be displayed at the EAA Museum during AirVenture 2010 along with all winning entries. The 2010 quilt blocks will remain on display for 12 months at the EAA Museum and be returned to you during the summer of 2011.

A separate entry form is required for each aviation quilt block submitted. All entries must be received by June 1st, 2010 and must arrive via U.S. Mail (no UPS, FedEx, etc., please). Please do not include three-dimensional decorations (buttons, etc.) on your quilt block if you would like it framed for museum display.
